Fluzone® & Flublok® Reservations by 4/17/2026!

CCPAPP would like to inform members that the 2026-2027 flu dose reservation process for Sanofi's Fluzone® and Flublok® is underway.

Please confirm your reservation by **4/17/2026** to receive a 2% direct discount on Fluzone Trivalent. To create or confirm your reservation, please review the

information below to get started.

Please Note the Following:

For direct purchases from Sanofi for the 2026-2027 influenza season, CCPAPP members may return a limited number of unused and expired doses for credit as follows:

- Up to fifteen (15) percent of each presentation of influenza vaccine shipped to your practice during the 2026-2027 influenza season may be returned for full credit.
- Sanofi will accept expired influenza vaccine returns **beginning May 1, 2027** and must be **returned by July 31, 2027**. Returns received outside of this window will not be accepted.
- Credit can be applied to any future direct purchases of Sanofi vaccines.

Reservation Process:

For CCPAPP members who are currently enrolled in Sanofi's Recurring Reservation program, your 2026-2027 Fluzone vaccine reservation has already been created for you. You will need to complete the reservation process by following the three steps below:

Step 1: Log onto www.vaccineshop.com and go to the Fluzone tab or call Sanofi at **1.800.VACCINE (1-800-822-2463)** by **April 17, 2026**.

Step 2: Review or adjust your reservation as needed (you may increase or decrease quantities or change presentations of your reservation).

Step 3: Review/update your contact information and delivery hours (if needed) and your reservation is confirmed.

If you are not currently enrolled in Sanofi's Recurring Reservation Program, you have until **April 17, 2026** to create your reservation.

ENFLONSIA™ (clesrovimab-cfor) Has Been Incorporated Into the Clinical Decision Support for Immunization (CDSi) Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Immunization Series

What is Clinical Decision Support for Immunization (CDSi)? CDSi resources provide a single, authoritative implementation-neutral foundation for health information technology (HIT) tools such as Immunization Information Systems (IIS), Electronic Health Records (EHRs), and Health Information Exchanges (HIEs). CDSi keeps HIT tools up-to-date with current CDC recommendations by automatically determining patient-specific immunization needs at the patient visit.

CDSi resources translate clinical recommendations into technical decision-making support³

 **Consult your IT/EHR team to ensure your system is up to date**

Before implementing the CDSi update, ensure that ENFLONSIA is available in your EHR system.

It can take time for products to appear in EHR product lists. If ENFLONSIA is not yet available in the EHR, it can be added manually. This will allow for a timelier transition to ENFLONSIA while helping to maintain accuracy in patient records.

To learn how to manually add ENFLONISIA to your EHR system, refer to internal or external EHR support resources.

Keep in mind that EHR security privileges tend to vary depending on practice size.

The below list may help determine who is most likely able to manually add ENFLONISIA:

- Small practice — the physician or practice administrator
- Mid-sized practice — system administrator, nurse, or any EHR super user
- Large practice — an IT staff member, clinical manager, or system administrator

ENFLONISIA can be administered and manually recorded in your practice while the CDSi is being updated in your system.

VAXNEUVANCE is a Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Recommended Option for All of Your Appropriate Pediatric Patients

The CDC, American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), and the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) recommend the use of VAXNEUVANCE as an option for routine vaccination in infants and children, as well as for vaccination in children with certain medical conditions.

A CDC recommended option

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommends VAXNEUVANCE pneumococcal 15-valent conjugate vaccine (PCV15) and PCV20 at parity for routine vaccination of healthy pediatric patients.

CDC recommendation on interchangeability

VAXNEUVANCE is a CDC recommended option for a [four \(4\) dose series](#) or for completion of a four (4) dose series initiated with another PCV.

Proactively studied in certain at-risk populations

VAXNEUVANCE is a CDC, AAP, and AAFP recommended PCV with specifically designed clinical studies of [pediatric populations with certain risk conditions](#).

Meningococcal B (MenB) Accounts for ~68% of All Vaccine-Type Meningococcal Disease Cases in Persons 16 to 23 Years of Age in the United States

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) voted to align the MenB vaccine schedule as two (2) doses (at zero (0) and six (6) months when used as a two-dose series) for healthy adolescents and young adults aged 16 through 23 years to provide short-term protection against most strains of MenB. The preferred age for MenB vaccination is 16 through 18 years. The decision to vaccinate should be made based on shared clinical decision-making.

Although uncommon, MenB can be unpredictable and have severe consequences, including death without warning.

A critical delay in medical attention: The average time before adolescents and young adults are taken to a hospital is 12 to 19 hours





MenB accounts for approximately 42.5% of all meningococcal disease cases in persons 16 to 23 years of age in the United States

CCPAPP is excited to announce a renewed partnership with Seqirus for the 2026-2027 influenza season.

For this influenza season, the following products are currently available for purchase by CCPAPP members in the presentations indicated below:

- **Fluad®: Seasonal influenza virus vaccine marketed under the FLUAD® brand**
 - Pre-filled syringes (PFS), 10 single dose pre-filled syringes per package
- **Flucelvax®: Seasonal influenza virus vaccine marketed under the FLUCELVAX® brand**
 - Pre-filled syringes (PFS), 10 single dose pre-filled syringes per package

Shipments:

For orders received by **April 17, 2026**, Seqirus will deliver the products according to the following dates and percentages:

- 35% of total products by August 28, 2026
- 75% of total products by September 25, 2026
- 100% delivery by October 9, 2026

Returns:

For the 2026-2027 influenza season, CCPAPP members may return each product purchased in accordance with the returns instructions available online at <https://flu360.com/returns>. The number of returnable doses shall not exceed **15%** of the doses for each individual product purchased. Products are defined as follows:

- FLUAD® brand
- FLUCELVAX® brand

Returnable doses shall include full and partial boxes of unused prefilled syringes. Expired returned doses not eligible for credit or federal excise tax may be returned for destruction only. All doses purchased must be returned on or before **June 28, 2027** at CCPAPP members' sole cost and expense. All returnable doses will be considered for full credit (including federal excise tax but excluding any earned prompt payment discount) up to the amount actually paid per dose.

Any vaccines purchased through a wholesaler or distributor must be returned to the respective wholesaler or distributor in accordance with its returns policy. If a CCPAPP member chooses to return a product purchased through a wholesaler or distributor to Seqirus, such CCPAPP member will not be eligible for return credit.

Returns:

Members who order a minimum quantity of 100 doses (10 packs) may **return up to 20%** of total doses received before December 31, 2026. All eligible returns must be sent to the authorized distributor no sooner than 15 days prior to the product's expiry, and no later than June 30, 2027.

Replacement:

Customers who are a recurring reservation participant, or alternatively, customers that place an order for a minimum of 100 doses on or before April 30, 2026, may replace up to 10% of accepted doses while supplies last, that are expiring before January 31, 2027 for use in the current season, rounded down to the nearest 10-pack. Customers must notify their distributor of the request to replace product no earlier than 15 days prior to the product's expiry and no later than February 4, 2027. Replacement doses are not eligible for return.

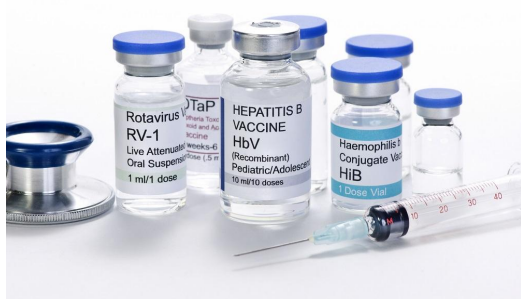
