



Dear Provider, Pharmacist, or College Health Administrator,

The state of Indiana passed a bill in 2017 requiring all students attending residential campuses at state colleges in Indiana to be immunized against meningococcal disease.¹ As of the Fall of 2018, Indiana University, Purdue University, Ball State University, and other universities will require first-year students to receive two doses of a serogroup B meningococcal disease (MenB) vaccine.²⁻⁴

Indiana University meningitis vaccine requirements²:

- **MenACWY (MCV4):** First year students aged 21 or younger must receive one dose on or after 16th birthday
- **MenB:** First year students aged 23 or younger must receive two doses

Purdue University meningitis vaccine requirements³:

- **MenACWY (MCV4):** One dose on or after 16th birthday
- **MenB:** First year students aged 23 or younger must receive two doses

Ball State University meningitis vaccine requirements⁴:

- **MenACWY (MCV4):** Proof of at least 1 dose on or after 16th birthday
- **MenB:** 2 doses if 23 years or younger
